Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for grant of the benefit of dual family pension to the petitioner.

The denial by the respondent-authorities on 17.10.2018 (Annexure P-5) is on account of Army No.3364572, not pertaining to Ex. Sepoy Late Gian Singh, in response to the legal notice dated 26.09.2018 (Annexure P-4).

A perusal of the discharge certificate of Late Gian Singh would go on to show that the serial number of the said Ex-Serviceman is 3364573.

In such circumstances, counsel does not press the present petition and prays for liberty to serve a fresh legal notice, giving the correct details of the Ex-Serviceman.

Writ petition stands disposed of, with the above-said liberty. It is expected that the respondents shall respond to the legal notice, to be sent, expeditiously, as has been done earlier.
