Petitioner is a diploma holder in Sangeet Bhushan. In the year 2016, an advertisement appeared in the newspaper inviting application for the post of Music Teachers. Petitioner being eligible applied for the same. A recruitment mela was held at Kisan Bhawan, Sector 35, Chandigarh from 17.9.2016 to 19.9.2016 for the post of Music Teacher. Petitioner participated in the same and was interviewed. His name figured at serial No.84 of the list. The department fixed 21.9.2016 as date for checking the educational qualifications. Petitioner appeared but could not produce the requisite certificate to show that he was a qualified diploma holder in Sangeet Bhushan. He procured the certificate only after the process was over and sent the same by a registered post to the respondent-Department. However, no response was received.

Aggrieved, petitioner has preferred the present petition. It is evident that petitioner sent his certificate to the department after the selection process was over. There is nothing on record to show that petitioner was given liberty to produce the certificate after the cut off date.

Under the circumstances, I find no merit in the petition and same is hereby dismissed.
