Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the prayer for stepping up/grant of higher pay to the petitioners at par with their junior counterparts as per the Haryana Civil Services (Revised Pay Rules, 2008 is covered by the decision of a Coordinate Bench in CWP No.11254 of 2010 decided on 15.5.2013 titled as **Neelam Rani versus The State of Haryana and others** (Annexure P-3) as well as order in review Annexure P-5 dated 4.7.2014 but despite notice having been accepted on 7.9.2017, no reply has been filed till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in the circumstances, the petitioners would be satisfied if at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the claim of the petitioners as made in the representation Annexure P-7 dated 6.4.2017 in accordance with law by taking into account the decision in **Neelam Rani's** case (supra) in a time bound manner.

Learned DAG, Haryana, states that he has no objection to the

unobscured prayer of the petitioners.

In the light of statement of learned counsel for the parties, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide representation Annexure P-7 dated 6.4.2017 in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Writ petition disposed of with the aforementioned directions.
