Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that at this stage, petitioners would be satisfied if their case is objectively considered in view of the judgment rendered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in *State of Haryana and others vs. Rajender Kumar and others* vide *Civil Appeal No. 321 of 2015* whereby adhoc service of the petitioners followed by regularization of the petitioners therein was held to be admissible for the purpose of counting the seniority.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that case of the petitioners herein is squarely covered by the abovesaid judgment.

3. However, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass a speaking order by considering the writ petition as a representation and also by keeping in view the contentions of the learned counsel for the petitioners as noted above.

4. It would be appreciated if the judgment rendered by the Apex

Court, *ibid* be also gone through before passing a speaking order and reasons of its non-applicability, in case, the competent authority comes to the said conclusion, be also recorded. In case, the petitioners' case is favourably decided, let the benefit arising therefrom be accorded to them within a period of two months.
