ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 49, dated 24.03.2019, under Section 306 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short), registered at Police Station Model Town Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he had taken money from the deceased 10 years ago and he was not returning the same, due to which the deceased committed suicide. He also contends that the allegations prima facie did not constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC and the petitioner is in custody for 2 ½ months. He further contends that co-accused Satnam Singh has already been granted anticipatory bail by this Court on 19.07.2019 in CRM-M-19271-2019.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Balkaran Singh states that the challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for 2½ months and conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
