ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.64, dated 18.01.2018, under Sections 120-B, 201, 218, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471 of IPC, registered at Police Station City Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the allegations in the FIR pertain to the incident which occurred in the year 2016 while the FIR has been registered in the year 2018. He further states that a sum of ₹30,000/- each from both the petitioners, who were working as Forest Guards, has already been recovered from their salaries as loss caused to the Government Exchequer.

This Court, by the order dated 25.07.2019, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim

bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Phool Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation and are not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioners and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 25.07.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
