The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 0070 dated 21.06.2018, registered under Sections 22 of the NDPS Act and 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station Kirtpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned State counsel, being instructed by SI-Mohan Lal, submits that out of 24 witnesses, 15 have already been examined. All the remaining witnesses are official witnesses only. The next date fixed before the trial court is 06.01.2020. Four witnesses have been summoned for the said date. The prosecution shall examine all the four witnesses on the said date and would also produce the remaining witnesses on the date next to be fixed after 06.01.2020.

Accordingly, this Court does not find any ground to interfere at this stage so as to grant bail pending trial, to the petitioner.

However, counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that the petitioner is in custody since 21.06.2018. Therefore, the trial of the case

deserves to be completed within time bound framed and accordingly, it is ordered that the prosecution shall complete their evidence latest by two months from 06.01.2020.

Petition stands disposed of.
