This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of direction to the respondents to release the due payment of the petitioner with regard to the work executed by him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the amount claimed by the petitioner has been made by the respondents during the pendency of the present petition. However, he submits that the interest on the delayed payment has not been made.

In view of the above, the Court feels that the intended purpose of filing the present petition is substantially achieved. As such,

the present petition stands disposed of.

However, the petitioner is free to represent the respondents with regard to the interest on the delayed payment. In case, he does so within one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this judgment, the competent authority will look into the matter and decide the same expeditiously as per law.
