As per pleadings on record, petitioner belongs to the Kinner community. Main occupation of such community is stated to be receiving alms/donations by giving blessings at the occasion of a new born or during marriage ceremonies.

Writ of mandamus is sought for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner by voicing an apprehension to the same at the hands of private respondent Nos.5 and 6 who are also stated to be belonging to the same very community.

Without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant writ petition in terms of granting liberty to the petitioner to approach the S.H.O., Police Station City Jagadhari, District Yamuna Nagar confined to the aspect of the threat that she apprehends to the life.

In the eventuality of any such application being filed, respondent No.3 would be obligated to look into the matter and to

thereafter take steps as he may deem fit and as warranted in accordance with law.
