The attribution to the petitioner, as per the FIR, being that he was carrying a pistol and that he exhorted his co-accused to teach the “complainant side a lesson” with the actual gun fire having been discharged from a rifle by Manjinder Singh (again as per the FIR), the petitioner already having been in custody for more than 02 years, with only 12 prosecution witnesses out of 28 examined, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case for or against the petitioner, the petition is allowed. The petitioner shall be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the learned trial Court.
