Grievance of the petitioners is that petitioner No.2 being the real brother of Rupinderjit Singh deceased employee is not being considered for an appointment on compassionate grounds.

2. Pursuant thereto, Petitioner No.1 has submitted a representation dated 24.06.2019 (Annexure P-4) to respondent No.2 with a request that the same may be considered and compassionate appointment be given to petitioner No.2 on account of death but the same has not been adverted by the respondents. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Given the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued, as there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 24.06.2019

(Annexure P-4) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

- 5. Let the needful be done within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
- 6. Disposed of in above terms.
