The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.204 dated 09.05.2019 registered under Sections 148, 149, 341, 379, 447, 506 and 511 IPC at Police Station Indri, District Karnal.

The operative part of the order dated 21.08.2019, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that much prior to the registration of the FIR, some of the accused persons have already approached this Court by way of filing a petition i.e. CWP Nos.27089 and 30793 of 2018 and No.1213 and 8072 of 2019, in which the dispossession of the petitioner has been stayed vide order dated 27.11.2018 and the order is still in operation.

Counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that the allegations in the FIR are that the complainant has taken the land in dispute on lease and has sown the crop and the accused persons did not allow him to cut the crop and extended threats and have even destroyed some of the crop of around ½ acre of the land. It is further submitted

that since the primary dispute is regarding the possession over the land in dispute, which is sub judice before this Court in the aforesaid writ petitions, therefore, no offense is made out.”

Notice of motion for 16.09.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 21.08.2019, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Padam Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 21.08.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
