By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of 'regular bail'.

Admittedly, the quantity of 'Opium' stated to have been recovered from the petitioner (as per the case of the prosecution), is 1.5 kgs, which is non-commercial quantity, with the co-accused of the petitioner, i.e. Govind Singh, already having been admitted to bail by this Court (Coordinate Bench) vide an order passed on 02.07.2019 in CRM-M-10025-2019.

That being so, without making any comments on the actual merits of the case, for or against the petitioner, with the trial nowhere near conclusion, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be admitted to bail upon his furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
