Mr. I.S.Brar, Advocate, has filed his power of attorney on behalf of the appellant in Court today. The same is taken on record.

As agreed, as per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant and learned counsel for the respondent – insurance company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹2,00,000/- (₹ Two Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Appellant has also put his signatures on the statement by way of gesture of his mother as he is 100% deaf and cannot understand anything.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the insurance company to deposit a crossed-cheque for ₹2,00,000/- in the name of the appellant – Balwinder Singh son of Sh.Sucha Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 14.10.2019, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – insurance company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.
