On the last date, learned counsel for the State on instructions from Mr. Dharam Pal, Superintendent, O/o Divisional Forest Officer, Bhiwani submitted that claim of the petitioner-Deep Chand (deceased) for regularisation has been accepted, however, the same is pending for sanction of the post.

Today again, a request is made that the matter is still pending for sanction of the post, however, it is submitted that the matter would be pursued at the quarter concerned and needful would be done within 10 weeks from today including crediting the monetary benefits in the account of the wife of deceased-Deep Chand.

In view of the statement made, the contempt petition is

disposed of.

However, it is clarified that in case the statement made today is not adhered to, the petitioners shall be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. In case they are forced to do so, costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable personally from the defaulting official(s). The respondents shall also provide the calculation of the amount found due to the petitioners. In case the petitioners are aggrieved of the same, they would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.
