Petitioner seeks a mandamus for directing the official respondents No.1 to 3 to take appropriate legal action in pursuance to a complaint/representation that the petitioner has filed against private respondents No.4 to 10.

Having heard counsel for the petitioner and having perused the pleadings on record, it stands conceded that certain proceedings before the revenue authority are already pending. In any case it is always open for the petitioner to take resort to his civil remedies for protection of his legal and vested rights pertaining to his properties.

The pleadings on record are insufficient for this Court to infer any imminent and immediate threat to the life and liberty of the petitioner.

In view of the above, no basis for interference is warranted.

Petition dismissed.
