[1] Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was promoted as Lecturer (Mathematics) vide order Annexure P-1 dated 24.04.2017 w.e.f. 01.01.2014 as against entitlement to promotion w.e.f. the year 1992 but vide order Annexure P-3 dated 18.05.2018, the promotion of the petitioner to the post of Lecturer (Mathematics) was ante-dated to 18.01.1996.

[2] Prayer in the writ petition is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to promote the petitioner to the post of Lecturer (Mathematics) w.e.f. January, 1992 instead of 18.01.1996.

[3] Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has submitted representations, Annexure P-4 dated 19.09.2018 and Annexure P-5 dated 15.11.2018 in respect of the aforementioned claim but the representations have not been decided till date and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if the writ petition is disposed of at this stage by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representations, Annexure P-4

dated 19.09.2018 and Annexure P-5 dated 15.11.2018 in accordance with law in a time bound manner.

[4] Without commenting on the merits of the claim or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representations, Annexure P-4 dated 19.09.2018 and Annexure P-5 dated 15.11.2018 in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
