The petitioners have challenged the orders dated 29.05.2007, dated 15.03.2013 and dated 02.03.2016 passed by the Collector, District Mahendergarh at Narnaul, the Commissioner, Gurgaon Division, Gurgaon and the Financial Commissioner, Haryana respectively.

Although learned counsel for the petitioners has vehemently argued that the impugned orders are patently illegal and liable to be set aside but could not cause any dent in the finding recorded by all the Courts below to the effect that the petitioners have been miserably failed to prove their ownership on or before the cut-off date.

In view thereof, there is hardly any merit in the present writ petition and the same is hereby dismissed as such though without any order as to costs.
