Pursuant to the order dated 15.10.2019, an affidavit of Sh. Sumit Sood, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division Malerkotla, has been filed. However, without going into the details thereof at this stage, with learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurpal Singh, submitting that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required presently, this petition, by which the petitioners seek the concession of 'anticipatory' bail, has actually been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such, with the order dated 06.09.2019 made absolute in terms of the aforesaid statement made.

However, the aforesaid order will not be treated to be an observation of this court on the merits of the case, but only in view of the fact that the investigating agency itself has stated that it does not require custodial interrogation of the petitioners.

Naturally, the complainant would be at liberty to avail of his legal remedy as regards any grievance, including the investigation process.
