As per pleadings on record, petitioner had solemnized marriage with Kuldeep Singh S/o Harpal Singh on 07.03.2019 as per Sikh rites and rituals at Gurudwara Jhiri Sahib, District Ludhiana.

Short grievance raised in the petition is that inspite of the application having been moved for registration of marriage under the Punjab Compulsory Registration of Marriage Act, 2012 in the office of Sewa Kendra, Mini Secretariat, Suvidha Centre, Ludhiana on 28.03.2019 and the file/application having been forwarded to the Registrar-cum-Tehsildar, Tehsil Jagraon, Ludhiana ,till date the registration certificate has not been issued.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Pal, learned DAG, Punjab accepts notice. A complete copy of the writ paper book has been furnished to her.

Statement of learned State counsel is recorded to the effect that in case the application submitted by the petitioner is complete in all respects

and there being no impediment in law, the marriage registration certificate would be issued to the petitioner expeditiously. Further statement recorded is that in case there is any objection to the issuance of the certificate, such objection would be reduced in writing and would be conveyed to the petitioner.

In the light of such statement recorded, no further directions are required to be passed.
