Pursuant to the order dated 21.08.2019, Mr. J.S. Toor, Addl. P.P., UT, Chandigarh, submits that as per his instructions, no FIR has been registered so far against the petitioner, who is being called to join investigation to determine as to how 310 condemned batteries went missing.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction that the petitioner shall not be summoned other than by due process of law as postulated in the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973; and in case he is sought to be arrested, adequate notice of 7 days would be given to him.
