Grievance of the petitioner is that notwithstanding that he is a regular employee of Government of Punjab and has been appointed as per applicable service Rules as Medical Physicist/RSO vide appointment letter dated 30.04.1999 (Annexure P-1), his salary for the period of four months from March, 2019 to June, 2019 has not been disbursed to him.

2. In the premise, the petitioner caused a Legal Notice dated 18.07.2019 (Annexure P-8) through his counsel but the same has not been adverted by the respondents till date. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Given the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued, as there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to

objectively consider the legal notice dated 18.07.2019 (Annexure P-8) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

5. Let the needful be done within a period of 60 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. Disposed of in above terms.
