Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 66 dated 11.07.2019, registered under Sections 406, 420 of the IPC; Section 13 of the Punjab Travel Professional Act, 2014 and Section 24 of the Immigration Act, 1983 at Police Station Banga, District S.B.S. Nagar.

Vide order dated 30.08.2019, while granting interim bail to the petitioner, he was directed to hand a demand draft of Rs. 75,000/- to the complainant.

Today, complainant Paramjit Lal and the petitioner are present in Court and have submitted that the matter has been compromised between them. Accordingly, both of them were referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court for recording of their respective statement.

The complainant, in his statement recorded before the

Mediator, has stated that he has received full and final payment of Rs. 30,000/- from the petitioner as settled between them. The Mediator has attached copy of the Aadhar Card of the complainant as his identification. Even, ASI Manvir Singh, who is present in Court, has not disputed the identity of the complainant.

In view of the above, the instant petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 30.08.2019, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
