Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 37, dated 15.10.2018, registered under Sections 323,324,326,341,148,149,120B IPC at Police Station Verka, District Amritsar.

FIR was lodged on the complaint of one Harjit Singh with the allegations that on 15.10.2018 at about 8.00/8.30 AM, when he was going on his splendor motorcycle and he reached near bye pass Muddhal Fatehgarh Sukharchak flyover then 3 clean shaven persons came on one motorcycle in muffled faces armed with swords, datar and baseball. They stopped him and started abusing him and caused injuries on various parts of body. Petitioner No. 1 is wife of complainant and petitioner No. 2 is father in law of complainant.

Allegation against petitioners, who are sister and father of accused Mandeep Singh (petitioner in CRM-M-31807-2019), is that they had instigated Mandeep Singh against complainant Harjit Singh, who is husband of petitioner No. 1 Surekha as there is a matrimonial dispute between them.

The learned counsel for petitioners states that no injury has been attribute to petitioners.

Vide order dated 26.9.2019, this Court, while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail, directed the petitioners to join the investigation.
