The grievance of the petitioner is that he is entitled to be considered for an appointment on compassionate grounds on account of his father having died in harness on 09.07.2016.

2. Pursuant thereto, he applied for a job as per applicable policy of compassionate appointments vide application annexed as Annexure P-1. The same was not considered and the petitioner has submitted his representations dated 20.05.2018 and 01.04.2019 (Annexures P-4 and P-5), respectively, requesting for considering his application for the job. However, representations were never adverted by the respondents. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Given the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued, as there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representations dated 20.05.2018 and

01.04.2019 (Annexures P-4 and P-5), respectively and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

5. Let the needful be done within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

6. Disposed of in above terms.
