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**ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)**

Learned counsel for respondent No. 2 submits that the judgment dated 30.07.2015 was recalled qua petitioners No. 2 to 4 vide order dated 09.01.2019.

After hearing learned counsels for the parties, I am of the opinion that the net effect of petitioners No. 2 to 4 of having been regularized w.e.f 01.07.2014 is that they would not be entitled to seek the relief of regularization, as granted to petitioners No. 1 and 5 vide judgment dated 30.07.2015, whereby the writ petition was originally disposed of.

However, it is made clear that petitioners No. 2 to 4 shall be entitled to all other benefits viz. the pecuniary benefits and continuity of service on parity with petitioners No. 1 and 5 other than the relief of regularization.

With these observations, the writ petition of petitioners No. 2 to 4 is disposed of.
