Grievance of the petitioner, inter alia, is that she has not been granted benefit of period of two years spent by her while undergoing the post graduation qualification as granted in case of other Medical Officers. Similarly situated have been given benefit of period of three years spent by them for post graduation qualification.

2. In the premise, petitioner submitted her representation dated 11.06.2019 (Annexure P-5) but the same was not adverted by the respondents. Hence, the writ petition.

3. Given the nature of order being passed, no notice is required to be issued, as there is no necessity to seek return by the respondents as no further proceedings and/or pleadings are required.

4. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to objectively consider the representation dated 11.06.2019

(Annexure P-5) and also by keeping in view the contentions stated in the present writ petition by treating it as a supplementary representation and pass a speaking order, in accordance with law.

- 5. Let the needful be done within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
- 6. Disposed of in above terms.
