1. It is submitted by Ld. Counsel for the petitioner that the parties have amicably resolved their dispute out of the Court. The petitioner has agreed to vacate the demised premises by 30.04.2020, and that he shall in the meantime, pay the current rent of demised premises in his possession for the remaining months.

2. In view of the above, Ld. Counsel appearing for the respondent submits that his client has no objection to this arrangement.

3. In view of the aforesaid submission, the present revision petition is disposed off in view of the compromise arrived at between the parties with the direction that the petitioner shall vacate the demised premises by 30.04.2020, subject to the agreed terms and conditions. Any execution pending against him shall remain stayed in the meantime.

4. This order shall automatically stand vacated after 30.04.2020.
