The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 89 dated 04.07.2019, registered under Sections 452, 323, 324 of the IPC at Police Station Dina Nagar, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the allegations in the FIR, a sudden altercation took place between the family members which resulted into scuffle.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has even joined investigation during the pendency of the bail application before the Additional Sessions Judge.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that only the offence under Section 452 IPC is non-bailable and the petitioner is ready to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh, has not disputed the factual position.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the petitioner

is granted anticipatory bail, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

If the petitioner is required for any further investigation, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon him by issuing a notice in writing.
