RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

Prayer in this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to allot the disputed land to the petitioner.

On 18.09.2019, this Court had passed an order calling upon the petitioner to provide documentary evidence on his right to cultivate the land beyond the fencing on the border of India and Pakistan.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is unable to produce any document supported by an application. Learned State counsel has asserted that the disputed land belongs to the provincial government and is in possession of the Canal Department, since 1967.

In view of the above, no ground for interference is made out.

The petition stands dismissed.
