Petitioner Harjinder Singh has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.14 dated 23.6.2018, under Sections 324, 323, 341, 506, 34 IPC (offence under Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran.

As per prosecution case, on 21.6.2018, Jaswant Singh, grandfather of complainant-Sukhjinder Singh had gone to water the fields. Thereafter, Bhupinder Singh, father of complainant went towards fields on his tractor and the complainant also went behind him on his motor-cycle. When Bhupinder Singh reached near the house of accused Kulwant Singh, J.E., Harjinder Singh and Manjinder Kaur came out of the house(s) and attacked the complainant. Accused Harjinder Singh gave datar blows and

Manjinder Kaur gave *dang* blow to the complainant and caused grievous injuries.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case as the incident took place on 21.6.2018, whereas the injured/complainant was medically examined on 22.6.2018 and the FIR was registered on 23.6.2018 with unexplained delay of two days.

Heard.

The petitioner is not only named in the FIR but he was armed with *datar* and inflicted three injuries upon the victim.

In view of the above, no case for granting extra-ordinary concession of anticipatory bail is made out.

Dismissed.
