(1) The present writ petition has been filed by Manish Sharma and 6 others *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondents to allow the petitioners to submit their online application forms for the post of TGT Sanskrit under Category 45 & 46 of the Advt.No.7/2016. It is further prayed by the petitioners that a direction be issued to respondent No.4 to conduct and declare the result of Haryana Teachers Eligibility Test (HTET) prior to completion of the selection process.

(2) During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the parties that after the filing of the present writ petition, HTET examination has already been held twice and therefore in the present writ petition, no further orders are called for. The writ petition has therefore become infructuous and as such no further orders are required to be passed.

(3) Accordingly, the writ petition is disposed of as having become infructuous.
