Petitioner-Sukhjinder Singh has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C for issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take action against respondent Nos.4 and 5.

It is not disputed that the civil suit brought by the petitioner is pending wherein the injunction has already been granted. It is also fairly stated by him that for violation of the injunction order, an application under Order 39 Rule 1 & 2 CPC is also filed by him which is pending.

Considering the above background and the contents of the alleged representation i.e. Annexure P-3, no ground is made out for invoking inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C.

Petition is dismissed.
