A short reply by way of affidavit of the Sub Divisional Magistrate, Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala has been filed in Court today and the same is taken on record. Copy has been furnished to counsel opposite.

The precise grievance raised in the petition is that for purpose of carving out a passage for VVIPs on account of celebrations of 550th Parkash Utsav of Shri Guru Nanak Dev Ji the respondent authorities are taking forcible possession of the land of the petitioner and which would result in destruction of paddy crop standing thereupon.

In para 4 of the reply a categoric stand has been taken that the passage in question is not being constructed upon or through the land of the petitioner and that the respondent authorities would have no concern with the land owned by petitioner as also the crop standing thereupon.

In view of such positive stand having been taken, nothing survives for adjudication in the instant writ petition.
