Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case bearing FIR No.0062 dated 09.05.2019, under Sections 452, 323, 147 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (*for short 'IPC'*), registered at Police Station Dinanagar, District Gurdaspur.

This Court, on the previous date of hearing i.e. 19.08.2019, passed the following order:-

“ Contends that there is delay in lodging the FIR as the occurrence had taken place on 21.12.2017 and the FIR was registered on 09.05.2019.

Notice of motion for 23.09.2019.

In the meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join the investigation before the Investigating Officer. In the event of their arrest, the Arresting Officer would admit them to interim bail in the present case till the next date of hearing on their furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to his satisfaction. The petitioners are also directed to abide by all

the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-30165-2019. ”

Contents that in terms of above order, petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel, on instructions from A.S.I. Jogender Singh, has acknowledged that in terms of order dated 19.08.2019, petitioners have joined the investigation and their custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, interim order dated 19.08.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

It is also made clear that petitioners shall fully co-operate with the Investigating Officer as and when called for further investigation.

Disposed off accordingly.
