After arguing for some time, when this Court was not inclined to accept the submissions made by the petitioner and was about to dismiss the writ, he prayed for withdrawal of the same with a further prayer for retention of premises No.C-5, Type-IV, GOP Compound, Ambala Cantt., District Ambala, for 15 days from today. When the case was earlier taken up, an affidavit was sought from the petitioner in this regard.

The said affidavit has now been filed in Court, dated 26.07.2019, wherein, it has been stated as follows:-

- “1. That the deponent has filed above mentioned Civil Writ Petition No.20517 of 2019 before this Hon'ble High Court.
2. That the deponent undertakes to vacate the premises No.C-5, Type-IV, GOP Compound, Ambala Cantt., District Ambala, within 10 days from today.
3. That the deponent may be allowed 15 days' time to vacate the said premises.”

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In the light of the above affidavit and taking a lenient view in the matter, petitioner is granted 15 days' time to vacate the premises from today i.e. upto 10.08.2019.

Petitioner, therefore, has to hand-over the vacant possession of premises No.C-5, Type-IV, GOP Compound, Ambala Cantt., District Ambala, on or before 11.08.2019. In case the petitioner fails to comply with the undertaking given to the Court in the affidavit, which has been filed in Court today, not only will he be liable to be proceeded against under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for violating the undertaking given to the Court but shall also be evicted by the Estate Officer (D.G.M. Planning B.S.N.L.), Ambala Cantt., District Ambala – respondent No.3 with police help. The Deputy Commissioner and Superintendent of Police, Ambala, are directed to supply/provide necessary support/police force for the said purpose.

Copy of this order be given **dasti** to the petitioner under the signatures of the Special Secretary of this Court.

Copy of this order be also forwarded to the Deputy Commissioner, Ambala as well as Superintendent of Police, Ambala, for information and compliance.
