Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.102 dated 03.06.2019 under Sections 458, 323, 148, 149 IPC (Section 307 IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Canal Colony, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

While granting interim bail to the petitioners, following order was passed by this Court on 29.07.2019: -

“In the petition, the petitioners relies upon the order dated 08.07.2019 in which interim bail was granted to the co-accused Vikas @ Kaku in CRM-M No.28359 of 2019 (Annexure P-4). It is further stated in the petition that as per the medical record, there is no such injury, which was declared dangerous to life and

Section 307 IPC was added after the petitioners were granted regular bail...”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioners have joined the investigation and are not required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Sukhdeep Singh, has not disputed the factual position and states that the petitioners are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 29.07.2019 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
