The instant writ petition has been filed praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus for directing respondent no.2 to take a final decision on the application dated 12.2.2015 and in terms of which the petitioner had sought renewal of his certificate of practice as a Notary.

During the course of hearing counsel representing the contesting Union of India has informed the Court that the application submitted by the petitioner has already been dealt with and an order dated 13.2.2018 has been passed by the Govt. of India, Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Legal Affairs declining his request for renewal.

A copy of the order dated 13.2.2018 has been furnished to counsel opposite in Court today.

Counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to raise a challenge to the order dated 13.2.2018 on all such grounds that may be available to the petitioner in accordance with law.
