Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No. 269 dated 12.07.2019 registered under Sections 420, 120-B and 34 of IPC, 1860, at Police Station City Barnala, District Barnala.

On 20.08.2019, this Court passed the following order :-

“ *Notice of motion for 20.09.2019.*

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. ”.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 20.08.2019 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhwinder Singh, stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 20.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
