ARUN MONGA, J.(ORAL)

1. Conceded stand of the respondents, as per short affidavit dated 17.12.2016, is that the pay revision sought by the petitioner by stepping up his pay with his junior Shri Ruli Ram cannot be granted to him, as the benefit given to Shri Ruli Ram is also liable to be reverted since the same was granted inadvertently. It is further deposed that once benefit given to Shri Ruli Ram is reverted, the petitioner's claim for stepping up of his pay would be rendered infructuous.

2. On the other hand, show cause notice dated 05.12.2016 (Annexure R-5) issued to Shri Ruli Ram is stated to have been dropped vide order dated 30.10.2018.

3. Copy of the said order has been handed to the learned counsel for the petitioner, in course of the hearing, by the learned counsel for the respondents and the same is also taken on record. Now that, the show cause notice issued to Shri Ruli Ram qua reversion of benefit has been dropped, the petitioner is, therefore, entitled to the claim of his pay

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revision by stepping up his pay at par with Shri Ruli Ram, in accordance with instructions/circulars dated 05.03.2009 and 23.11.2009 (Annexures P-5 and P6, respectively.)

4. In the premise, respondents are directed to step-up pay of the petitioner at par with Shri Ruli Ram. Petitioner shall be entitled to arrears of salary alongwith @ 7 per annum. Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
