The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks quashing of the impugned action of the respondent No.3 in not releasing revised pension, in compliance of the order dated 21.02.2017 (Annexure P-4).

In response to the claim for the payment of the revised pension w.e.f. 01.01.2006, the respondents in the written statement have stated that the amounts have been remitted to the account of the petitioner in the Central Bank of India, Bhiwani and reference has been made to the communication dated 01.09.2018 (Annexure R-5). Relevant paragraph of the written statement reads as under:-

“12. That in reply to para no.12 of the petition, it is submitted that the said averments pertains to respondent no.3. However, it is to mention here that on receipt of documents alongwith this WP his pension revision case has been sent to PAD BSF, New Delhi in amended form and the same has

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been released also. The revised pension of Rs.10,850/- & Family Pension Rs.9,000/- which was forwarded by 38 Bn BSF on 01 Sept 2018, mentioned in (**Annexuure- R-5**) has been passed by CPAO New Delhi on 12 Sept' 2018 and payment also remitted in the new bank A/C No.3293062618 of the petitioner i.e. Central Bank of India, Bhiwani, Branch Code 2605. Hence, no action of the respondent is against the natural justice and violative of article 14 & 16 of the Constitution of India.”

Counsel for the petitioner does not have any fresh instructions contrary to the stand of the respondents.

Accordingly, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed off as such.
