The petitioner, a Nigerian National, prays for concession of regular bail in FIR No.56 dated 17.11.2018, registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 14 of the Foreigner Act, 1946, at Police Station S.T.F., Phase-4, S.A.S. Nagar, District S.A.S.Nagar.

Initially, the petitioner was found in possession of 270 grams of Heroine and later on, on his disclosure, another 200 grams Heroine was recovered from the place of his residence.

As per the notification, commercial quantity with reference to Heroine is more than 250 grams.

Learned State counsel has informed that the petitioner is also involved in another NDPS case in FIR No.420 dated 07.12.2017, Police Station Zirakpur, under Section 21 of the NDPS Act.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Court is not inclined to release the petitioner on bail.

Dismissed.

However, Special Court concerned is requested to make a sincere endeavour to conclude the trial within a period of one year from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
