The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.55, dated 14.05.2019, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the allegations against the petitioner are that while he was taking the examination, mini listening device was recovered from him. He also contends that several similarly situated co-accused have been granted regular bail by the Coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-27281-2019, CRM-M-30659-2019, CRM-M-30713-2019, CRM-M-30749-2019, CRM-M-30943-2019 on 26.07.2019 and in CRM-M-30478-2019 on 25.07.2019. He further states that the petitioner is in custody for over five months and is not involved in any other case.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is in custody for over five months, he is not involved in any other case, similarly situated co-accused have been granted regular bail and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
