In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that he is entitled for the pay scale of Rs.570-1080 w.e.f. 01.01.1984, Rs.1500-2640 w.e.f. 01.01.1986 and also the senior scale of pay of Rs.1800-3200 w.e.f. 01.09.1993 which is already granted to the Agriculture Sub Inspectors working in the Soil Conservation and Engineering Department.

In support of his claim, petitioner is relying upon the order passed by this Court in CWP No.6223 of 2000 titled as Balkar Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, decided on 17.09.2012 (Annexure P-6) as well as the order passed by this Court in CWP No.22834 of 2013 titled as Nirmal Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and another, decided on 22.03.2018 (Annexure P-8).

From the pleadings, it transpires that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has served the respondents with a legal notice dated 04.06.2019 (Annexure P-11) and the interest of justice will be served, in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondents to decide the said legal notice by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by him in the legal notice dated 04.06.2019 (Annexure P-11), the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 04.06.2019 (Annexure P-11) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, it is found that the petitioner is entitled for any monetary benefits after the decision of the legal notice, the same should also be paid to him within three months thereafter.
