This is a petition under section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.117 dated 16.06.2019 under sections 406, 498-A, 323, 506 IPC registered at Police Station P.S. Khanna, City 2, District Khanna.
