Prayer in the present petition is to grant regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 271 dated 2.11.2018 registered under Sections 18, 29 of NDPS Act and under Sections 190(2), 192, 196 of Motor Vehicles Act, 1988, at Police Station Samrala, District Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has been nominated as an accused on the statement of co-accused. He further submits that there is no recovery from the petitioner. He further draws attention of the Court to the order dated 22.7.2019 passed in CrI. Misc. No.M-17683-2019 granting concession of regular bail to the co-accused from whom the alleged narcotics were recovered.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State has submitted that the petitioner is also involved in another criminal case under NDPS Act in the State of Uttarakhand.

On a pointed question, learned counsel for the State after getting instructions from ASI Baldev Singh has informed the Court that

apart from the disclosure statement, the prosecution has oral statement

of alleged independent witness Buta Singh.

Petitioner is in custody since 10.5.2019. Investigations are complete.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, in the considered view of the Court, petitioner deserves the concession of bail and therefore, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Accordingly, the present petition is allowed.
