Grievance of the petitioners herein is with regard to non-implementation of certain recommendations as reflected from Minutes of Meeting dated 24.07.2012 (Annexure P-10) chaired by the then Hon'ble Chief Minister.

Having perused the same, I am of the view that so called recommendations were only made way back in the past and while doing so, it was also observed that a desired memorandum be prepared and submitted for consideration by the Cabinet of the Ministers.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that thereafter, no decision has been taken till date by the Cabinet in terms of the Minutes of Meeting, *ibid*.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners seems to be correct as a perusal of the return filed on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2 particularly para 4 thereof would reveal that the stand taken is that even though, it was not mandatory to adjust the petitioners but at the same time, no decision has since been taken by the Cabinet regarding their adjustment, therefore, no order has been passed till date.

In the aforesaid premise, writ petitions are disposed of with an observation that let appropriate decision be taken in terms of the Minutes of Meeting and appropriate orders be passed, in accordance with law.

Let the needful be done within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
