Pursuant to order dated 13.08.2019, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are cooperating therewith.

The present FIR has been registered with the allegation that the petitioners have fabricated an entry in the Daily Diary Register of ACP (North) Jalandhar. According to the said entry, a complaint was submitted by the petitioners against the complainant of the present FIR.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is no forgery of any entry. The complaint infact was submitted and the same is Annexure P-4 on record.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Hardev Singh submits that the matter was enquired into and it has been found that the said entry has been made by one Paramjit Singh, Reader in the office of ACP (North) Jalandhar.

The complainant submits that the entry was fabricated with the intention of harassing him. Infact, no complaint had been filed but pursuant to the entry made in the Daily Diary Register notices under Section 160 Cr.P.C. were issued to the complainant.

Be that as it may, it is apparent that the allegation against the petitioners is minor in nature. They have also joined investigation and are cooperating therewith and I see no reason to withdraw the interim protection already granted to them. In case any offence has been committed by the petitioners, they shall be punished for that by the trial Court.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted vide order dated 13.08.2019, is hereby made absolute subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. by the petitioners.
