ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.104 dated 13.04.2019, under Sections 395, 411, 148 and 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Jandiala Guru, District Amritsar Rural.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it has been mentioned that 15-16 persons had taken away 1800 bags of wheat in two trucks after breaking the locks of the godown. He further contends that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner. The petitioner is 23 years of age and is in custody for about four months. He also contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in other two FIRs wherein he has not been named.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Balwinder Singh, states that although charges have been framed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner is 23 years old and is in custody for about four months, he is not named in the FIR and conclusion of trial is likely to take sometime, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
