The petitioner by way of instant petition is seeking directions to the respondents for release of goods comprising of “Old Used Digital Multifunctional Devices imported vide Bill of Entry No. 3166476 dated 09.05.2019 at the port of ICD Kanech, Sahnewal, Ludhiana, having been illegally detained by the respondents and therefore challenging the power and authority of respondent No.3 for illegal detention of goods, without passing any order under the provisions of the Customs Act, 1962. The aforesaid action of the respondents in detention of the goods is against the provisions of Customs Law as well as violative of Articles 14, 19 & 21 of the Constitution of India. Hence the instant writ petition praying for clearance of the goods u/s 110 A read with Section 19 of the Customs Act, 1962.

Upon notice, the Department of Customs has filed its reply.

At the time of hearing, learned counsel for the petitioner prays

that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition.
